Important Information. Changes to The Ring Road.

A significant part of the redevelopment work at Junction 6 Coventry City Centre Ring Road is now complete. The bridge deck improves links between Friargate and the City Centre having removed the raised roundabout and built a 100 metre wide bridge across the ring road junction, creating a new road layout and a public boulevard linking the railway station through Greyfriars Green directly into Bull Yard.

Please note: Warwick Road, when travelling

from New Union Street direction towards the new junction, will be for buses, taxis and cyclists only. All other vehicles will need to turn right into Greyfriars Road. This is monitored by an enforcement camera and any vehicles using this road, will be issued with a fine.

We don't want you to receive a fine when you drive to our office, so please familiarise yourself with the information below and the directional arrows on the map. By **Inbound** we mean heading towards the City Centre, by **Outbound** we mean heading away from the City Centre towards the ring road.

Arriving to our Office

Drivers approaching the City Centre from the ring road should exit on the slip road at Junction 6, from either direction, and turn onto Warwick Road heading Inbound, and then turn right into our car park, but should not drive through the Bus Gate (between the two sign posts).

Pedestrians can safely walk from Station Square using the new pedestrian walkway and zebra crossings all the way to our office on Warwick Road. No change to access walking from the City Centre.

Leaving our Office

Drivers can turn left or right on exiting our car park.

Pedestrians can safely walk from our office on Warwick Road using the new pedestrian walkway and zebra crossings towards Station Square. No change to access walking towards the City Centre.
